## THE ORDER OF THINGS | LEIF LOW-BER

TYPOLGY is pleased to present our spring exhibition, *THE ORDER OF THINGS* or, *The Second Conference of the International Network of Personal Relationships (INPR)*. This exhibition features new and recent work by Leif Low-Ber (Toronto/NYC), an artist who engages in a playful reordering of ideas, images, and expectations through the use of constructed, multipart, and/or recombined compositions of drawings, collages, assemblages, and sculptural tableaux.

Evincing a keen interest in the mark of the hand, relationships between figures in space, and the active engagement of the viewer, Leif Low-Ber creates unstable, interchangeable images through a process of assembling and adapting individual works to each other and to the exhibition space. In so doing, Low-Ber questions how changing relationships between works alter meaning, and encourages viewers to actively participate in the creation and interpretation of these meanings for themselves.

An exhibition catalogue with original curatorial essay and a limited-edition print produced in collaboration with the artist will accompany the show. Exhibition-related events include an artist/curator Q+A, catalogue launch, and family-friendly sculpture workshop with the artist. ### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Leif Low-Ber is an artist based in Brooklyn, NY. Growing up in Toronto, he attended Guelph University (ON), then the School of Visual Art (NY), garnering degrees in philosophy, visual art, and design. His sculptures and drawings have been shown in solo shows at Buffalo Arts Studio (Buffalo, NY), Beginnings (Brooklyn, NY), Okay Mountain (Austin, TX), and Wild Project (New York, NY). A large-scale installation at Socrates Sculpture Park (Queens, NY) was part of the VISTA exhibition in 2011. *THE ORDER OF THINGS* will be Low-Ber's first solo show in Canada.
